

Below are some steps we recommend you take if you are involved in collision. It's a good idea to print a couple of copies of this form to keep in your glovebox.

<u>At the Scene</u> Stop your car immediately. You can be heavily penalised for failing to stop after a collision.

<u>Help injured persons</u> Help anyone who is injured from their vehicles and make them comfortable. Do **not** move seriously injured people before trained help arrives unless to avoid further injury from traffic, fire or explosion. Call an ambulance if necessary.

<u>Prevent further collisions</u> Ask bystanders to warn approaching traffic. Do not stand on the roadway. Where possible, clear the roadway of people and vehicles.

Arrange a tow if your vehicle can't be driven away
